- ✓ Assist the judges and stewards by sending in only those entries that are of a high standard. **(PLEASE, no whole class sets)**
- ✓ Where possible, laminating exhibits before sending in is recommended.

- ✓ Handwriting exhibits must be on appropriate year level lines.
- ✓ Correct spelling and punctuation is expected.

## CATEGORY - CREATIVE WRITING

- ✓ Creative writing exhibits may be about any school appropriate topic or theme.
- ✓ Writing may be published in either hand written format (on school lined exercise paper) or typed and printed format.
- ✓ Work will be judged on: text type structure and cohesion, sentence construction, punctuation and spelling, creativity and neat presentation.
- ✓ Length of exhibit to be consistent with year level expectations for Australian Curriculum Achievement standards. (as per English work samples)
- ✓ Students may choose to enter one exhibit type or all 4, but may not enter two of the same type. (For example, A year 6 student may not enter 2 news articles, BUT may enter one news article and one poem.)

- ✓ All Writing exhibits- a written piece of work in the target language studied at school, on any topic.
- ✓ All Writing exhibits- may be handwritten or typed.
