TERMS:

1. Cane exhibits must be the bona fide property of cane farmers, holding not less than 5 hectares of growing area in the Rocky Point Mill area.
2. Entries must be received by 5pm on Thursday. Entry Fee is \$2.00 per entry. No late entries will be received. Judging on Friday.
3. Exhibits must be securely labelled with the Name of Competitor and Class.
4. The inclusion of suckers in Class 1 to 10 inclusive are allowed.
5. Only one entry per grower of each approved variety is allowed in Class 11.
6. Prizes shall be awarded, providing that, in the opinion of the judges, the standard of the exhibit or exhibits is sufficiently high to merit the awards.
7. Points to be awarded for this section will be – three points for first – two points for second and one point for each exhibit staged.
8. All entries will become the property of the Beenleigh Show Society after entry and following the display will be disposed of, in accordance with local disease quarantine regulations.

Note: Exhibits to be tied and labelled with name and class and ready by 12=midday on Thursday prior to the show.

CLASSES 11-15

11. Standover – an exhibit of three stalks of any approved variety.
12. Collection of sugar cane – 2 stalks of each of three of the above approved varieties.
13. Rocky Point Mill CCS Competition. Bundle of cane to contain six stalks of the same variety with tops left on the stalks. Each stalk to show not less than 1.5 metres of cane. Judge to select three stalks for display.
14. Longest stalk of cane
15. Heaviest stalk of cane.
