## **HOW TO EXHIBIT** (Sections 11 to 24 inclusive)

1. Complete the entry form (in back of schedule) and post with entry fee to Beenleigh Show Society, Post Office Box 66, Beenleigh, Qld 4207  
**Or** Email Entry form to **reception@beenleighshow.com.au** and pay entry fees into **Westpac BSB 034605 Account No 000041** using the first three letters of your surname and Section No as your reference.  
All completed forms must be received by 5 p.m. on **WEDNESDAY** 26th February 2025. Additional entry forms are available from the Secretary or may be photocopied.
2. Exhibits will be received by the Stewards from 7.30 a.m. to 12 noon on **FRIDAY** March 7th 2025. Please take exhibits to the Pavilion. Tickets must be attached by sellotape or pin to the articles before handing to the Stewards.
3. Exhibits will be judged from 1.00 p.m. **FRIDAY** March 7th 2025.
4. Exhibits must be collected on **SUNDAY** March 9th between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. No exhibits may be removed before 10 a.m. Stewards are not responsible for exhibits after 11 a.m. on Sunday March 9th, 2025.
5. **DISPLAY/HANGING OF EXHIBITS:** Not all exhibits may be displayed or hung.
6. **PRIZES.** First \$10.00 - Second \$5.00 unless otherwise stated. Where a trophy is allocated, there is no cash First Prize.
7. **ENTRY FEES:** \$2.00 unless otherwise stated.
8. An Exhibitor whose Entry Fees are \$50 or over will receive a **FREE PASS** to the 2025 Annual Show.
9. **Late Entries will only be accepted in Section 13 (Cut Flowers)**
10. Points for Sections 11 to 24 inclusive will be : first - three points : second - one point. In the event of a tie for Most Successful Exhibitor, the Trophy will be awarded to the person awarded the most First prizes.
11. To collect exhibits, **Entry Docket must be presented to the Stewards.** No one is to remove their exhibits from the display, as this is the responsibility of the Stewards.
12. Prize money and trophies may be collected between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sunday from the Secretary's Office.

Please check the class description to ensure your work is entered in the correct section. Stewards may change the class of any item entered incorrectly without reference to exhibitor.

All quilts/wall hangings **must have a label with entrants name & contact number.**  
Must also have a rod pocket - minimum 3 1/2 inches depth, by width of quilt.

### Class

1. Applique Quilt - Majority technique is applique.
2. Art Quilt - Pictorial or Abstract.
3. Pieced Quilt - Predominately pieced - hand or machine quilted - self quilted only.
4. Pieced Quilt - Predominately pieced - commercially or professionally quilted.
5. Pieced & Appliqued Quilt - Significant portion of both techniques.
6. Quilt, incorporating hand embroidered blocks.
7. Modern Quilt - Demonstrating a modern aesthetic.
8. Group/Collaborative - Quilt made by 2 or more persons.
9. Other techniques - Quilt not fitting to any other categories - crazy, hand/machine embroidered, sashiko, boro etc..
10. Second Chance - Quilts made predominately from materials that have had a previous life.
11. First time Entrant Quilt or Item - Any technique
12. Persons over 65 - Any patchwork or quilted item.
13. Intermediate Entrant - 13 years and under 17 - Quilt or any item.
14. Junior Entrant under 13 years - Quilt or any item.
15. Challenge - "**DAISY, DAISY**". Persons wishing to enter, please take a piece of fabric and place your name on the list. Complete the entry form and deliver to the Show office or enter via online. The entry form is the same form as for all craft sections.

**The following conditions apply to enter the challenge quilt class.**

- Create - quilt, wall hanging, or item using one (1) challenge piece of fabric provided by Beenleigh Show Society.
- Any article of choice under following conditions:
  - \* Size limited to 24 inches square.
  - \* Must use at least 60% of challenge fabric.
  - \* No additional challenge fabric to be used other than piece provided.
  - \* Any other fabric may be used to finish the article.
