IMPORTANT INFORMATION- please read carefully

- ✓ Full care will be taken with all exhibits, but stewards and judges hold no responsibility for damage or loss.
- ✓ All work must have been executed since January 2024 solely by the exhibitor.
- ✓ Primary school students only.
- ✓ Entry is free.
- ✓ Each exhibit can appear and be judged once only.
- ✓ Only one entry per student in each exhibit area. (For example, A year 6 student may enter one news article and one poem BUT not enter 2 news articles.)
- ✓ Exhibits not conforming to all requirements will not be judged.
- ✓ Schools are asked to have exhibits of the same category grouped (clipped together if possible) when sending in entries.
- ✓ Assist the judges and stewards by sending in only those entries that are of a high standard. **(PLEASE, no whole class sets)**
- ✓ Where possible, laminating exhibits before sending in is recommended.

Entries may be on appropriate year level lines or blank paper. <i>The Beenleigh Show has been a much-anticipated event in the Beenleigh community since 1872. Showgoers can enjoy many exciting attractions- including displays of artwork and cooking, visiting animals, roving entertainment and of course, rides and showbags.</i> <i>The Beenleigh Show - Great entertainment for the whole family!</i>

CATEGORY - CREATIVE WRITING



- ✓ Creative writing exhibits may be about any school appropriate topic or theme.
- ✓ Writing **MUST** be in edited and published form- in either hand written format (on school lined exercise paper) or typed and printed format.
- ✓ Work will be judged on: text type structure and cohesion, sentence construction, punctuation and spelling, neat presentation, and creativity.
- ✓ Length of exhibit to be consistent with year level expectations for Australian Curriculum Achievement standards. (as per English work samples)
- ✓ Students may choose to enter one exhibit type or all 4, but may not enter two of the same type. (For example, A year 6 student may enter one news article and one poem, BUT not 2 news articles.)

- ✓ All Writing exhibits- a written piece of work in the target language studied at school, on any topic, may be hand written or typed.
